EASTERN PENNSYLVANIA SKI COUNCIL CUP RACE

2018 RACE RULES

1. All racers must be 21 or older
2. Master racers must be 60 and older.
3. This is a TEAM event. A team consists of 6 people; two women and four men make up a valid team.
4. Season Pass or Lift tickets must be paid in order for an individual to be registered on a team. Race fees will be paid by the Council.
5. Each team must designate a team captain. The first two bib spots on each team must be assigned to women, the next four spots must be assigned to men.
6. Participants must complete the registration packet consisting of the team registration form (team captain to fill in ski club name, names of racers, and age), six waivers for Montage and six waivers from EPSC plus read the rule sheet. All of these items will be available on the website prior to the event. The registration form and all waivers must be emailed prior to the race and be complete and legible, or they will not be accepted and the bib spots will not be assigned. **Forms can be found online at easternpascouncil.org and must be emailed to the Senior Alpine Director, Jared Walck at jared.walck@gmail.com prior to February 25th.**
7. Each ski club must choose a person responsible for turning in the team materials. All materials must be turned in for a team to be registered. Due to Montage's timing system requirements, materials must be completed and turned in before the race day to provide adequate time for data input. There can be only one substitution made per team in case of emergency. Therefore, if the designated person arrives, that person can check in for the substitute.
8. The bibs will be given in the order of the arrival of the entries. The first entries will be the first bib order, etc. Entries will not be accepted the day of the event unless notification has been approved by Jared Walck.
9. The race begins at 10:00 AM. Course inspection must be done by 9:00 am. Masters Teams will go first. Racers will be called to the start gate. Racing will continue in this manner until each team has completed their first run. After each team has completed their first run, the race course will be reset. Racers will be notified once the second course is complete. For the second run reverse order will take place, however the Masters group will again be the first to go.
10. A team score for each race is made up of the best female time and the three best male times on that particular course. Each racer must ski once on each course. The score of each course will be combined to get the final score of each team. Three males and one female, minimally, must finish each course in order for your team to qualify. If this minimum is not met, your team will be DSQ. If any racer **Does Not Finish** the race, they will get a **DNF** as a time.
11. At the start gate, the gatekeeper will have a spreadsheet and announce the racers for each run. Make sure your racer is wearing the correct bib number.
12. After the last race, the team captain can get a copy of the race result to hand out for your team's viewing.
13. The A-Cup will be awarded to the team with the fastest team time. The B-Cup will be awarded to the fastest team from a Club other than the Club winning the A-Cup. The Master's Cup will be awarded to the team over 60 with the lowest time. Snowboard Teams will also be welcomed.
14. Individual Awards will be given to the Fastest Man and Woman In all groups for Fastest Combined Time.
15. The Frank Cressman Award will be awarded to the fastest single run by a Master's racer.
