

EPSC Lift Voucher Program, CHANGES. This seems to be the Politically Correct way of doing it differently. In the Spring Issue of SnowDrifts, I indicated a few changes to be installed in the program. I hope that these will make the procedure work more smoothly and more importantly make my job easier. When ordering vouchers, start by downloading the Order Form off of the EPSC website, and making copies. Please be very frugal and order only the vouchers you will need short term. I will usually have an inventory of vouchers and can fill most orders within a few days. The reason for this is all vouchers returned for refund or credit will cost you \$1.00 each. Fill out the form completely. Do the math and forward the form to the address on the form, with an Self Addressed Stamped Envelope or where you want the vouchers sent. If for some reason you need them "now", use the E-mail address on the form and give me a "HeadsUp" then send the form anyway and mark it "E-Mailed". Just a few more things. Please make sure the envelope is large enough to hold your order. Also, the program is intended for the use of EPSC members only. If someone at work or a neighbor wants you to buy vouchers for them, please ask them to join your ski club. It's more likely to be less than the savings on the vouchers. Also please carry your club membership card when using the vouchers. The person at the window may ask to see it.
