

## **EASTERN PENNSYLVANIA SKI COUNCIL CUP RACE**

**FEBRUARY 28, 2010**

### **BLUE MOUNTAIN SKI RESORT**

The Eastern Pennsylvania Ski Council is pleased to announce the 2010 Council Cup Race venue. The race is scheduled for February 28, 2010 at Blue Mountain Ski Resort. Race start is scheduled for 10:30 am with registration closing at 9:15 am. Breakfast is provided from 8 am to 9:30 am and after race munchies will be served at 12 noon. Lift tickets and race registration are available upstairs at the upper lodge starting at 8 am. The cost for race, food, beverages and the awards party is \$50 per racer. A separate race will be held for snowboarders.

Team members must be listed on entry forms at the time of registration. No substitutions for racers may be made once a team is registered. As in the past, the race will be conducted on Raceway. Trophy awards consist of the A Cup, B Cup and the Master's Cup. Please purchase your lift ticket through EPSC as this helps defray costs for the day's event. ### **EPSC 2009 COUNCIL CUP RULES**

- 1 – All racers must be 21 years of age.
- 2 - Master racers must be 50 years or older.
- 3 – This is a team event. A team consists of six (6) people; two (2) women and four (4) men.
- 4 – Lift tickets and race registration fees must be paid in order for an individual to register on a team.
- 5 – Each ski club must choose a captain and this captain is responsible for registering their respective team.
- 6 – Team captains are responsible to collect a registration packet which consists of a team registration form, waiver forms, and a rule sheet. All completed registration forms and waivers must be returned to the registration table in order to receive bibs.
- 7 – The first two bib slots on each team must be assigned to the women on the team.
- 8 – Racers will be instructed as to the order of the race when arriving at Raceway the morning of the race. There are two courses, red and blue. Racers will be called to the start gate by EPSC representatives and the Blue Mountain Race Crew.
- 9 – After the first run, racers must report back to the top of Raceway for their second run which is on the opposite color course.

10 – A team score for each race is made up of the best female time and the three best male times on that particular course. Each racer must ski once on the red course and once on the blue course. The score of each course will be combined to get the final score of each team. Three males and one female, minimally, must finish each course in order for the team to qualify. If this minimum is not met, the team will be disqualified. If any racer does not finish a run, they will receive a DNF.

11 – Team captains, please ensure each racer is wearing the correct bib and is ready to start when called to the start gate by the race official.

12 – Team captains will receive a copy of the race results during the awards ceremony which is conducted one and a half hour after the final racer completes the course.

13 – The A Cup is awarded to the fastest ski team and the B Cup is awarded to the sixth place team. The Master Cup is awarded to the fastest team age 50 and over. Special recognition will go to the fastest snowboard team.
